




Welcome to Shakespeare Class! Class Teachers: Mrs Cardall and Mr Angus

Our timetable

Alongside the core subjects of literacy, reading and maths, which are taught every morning, we will also be using the school's Hub building to enjoy art, ICT and music lessons. These subjects take place from Tuesday to Friday. Additionally, the children's timetable includes science, history, geography and RE.

Themes & topics
