

Personal, Social & Emotional Development (PSED)


- ❖ Be confident to speak about their ideas and will independently choose the resources they need
- ❖ Begin to negotiate and solve problems without aggression
- ❖ Play cooperatively and take turns with others.

Communication & Language (CL)

- ❖ Listen to stories and respond with relevant questions and comments
- ❖ Follow instructions
- ❖ Listen and respond to the ideas of others during a conversation
- ❖ Use language to create and imagine roles within a play situation.

Physical Development (PD)

- ❖ Changing for PE and organising belongings
- ❖ Understanding how to stay healthy
- ❖ Move confidently in arrange of ways, negotiating space
- ❖ Uses one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. scissors, pencils, hole punch etc.
- ❖ Beginning to form recognisable letters.

Literacy (LIT)

- ❖ Writes own name and simple words using clear letters
- ❖ Beginning to write captions, labels and short sentences
- ❖ Beginning to read words and simple sentences
- ❖ Texts
 - Supertato series
 - Super Daisy
 - Superworm
 - Super Pigs

Please read with your child every day – “little and often” is best.

Understanding the World (UW)

- ❖ Look at similarities and differences between themselves and others
- ❖ Recognise the Superheroes in our everyday lives

Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)

- ❖ Investigate different media and materials, creating collages and models
- ❖ Introducing narratives and storylines in their play
- ❖ Create simple representations of people and objects
- ❖ Construct with a purpose in mind

Mathematical Development (MD)

- ❖ Recognises numerals 1-5 and then 1-10 and 0
- ❖ Number bonds to 5 and then 10
- ❖ Combining two groups to find the total
- ❖ Beginning to use mathematical names for 2D and 3D shapes, e.g. triangle, rectangle, sphere and cube
