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Nursery

This week in Nursery we have been reading 'Supertato: Run Veggies, Run'. The children are really enjoying this series of stories, particularly coming to school each morning to discover what Evil Pea has been up to in our classroom overnight! We have been making Evil Pea wanted posters, as well as making our own superhero badges to wear. The children also cut up lots of different vegetables and helped to make vegetable soup.



Reception

This week we have been reading Super Daisy and the Peril of Planet Pea. We have been looking at special words that sound like the sound they are representing (onomatopoeia), e.g. crash, bang, zoom. We have used these words to create our own comic strips about a superhero.

In Phonics we have learned the new sounds: j, w and z. We have practised listening for these sounds in words and learning to write them using our pre-cursive letters. Writing some of these letters is very tricky. Please try and encourage your child to do some mark-making/writing at home. Your child could write a list when you go to the supermarket, write a card to a relative or write you a note about what he/she would like for dinner.



We have also started to learn our 'tricky words'. These are words that we have to remember as they cannot be sounded out, such as the, to, no and go. The children are getting really good at recognising these words and we have started writing them too.

In Maths we have been looking at the numbers 9 and 10. We can now represent these numbers using the numerals, tens frames and numicon. Maths is all around us, so please encourage your child to look out for numbers around the house.
