## Attention all Nursery Parents

We would like to make you aware that, in addition to accepting paper application forms for Reception 2020 up until 10<sup>th</sup> February, the Local Authority are, for the first time also keeping the online admissions system ([www.kent.gov.uk/ola](http://www.kent.gov.uk/ola)) open for parents applying to start school in September this year. That means parents can apply online and still receive an offer on Primary National Offer Day (16 April) as long as it is submitted by 10 February. Please apply without delay to secure your place at Temple Grove; if you require any advice or support please speak to our lovely office staff.

## Uniform Update

We are very pleased to announce that from September 2020 we will be making some changes to our School Uniform which will effect children in Early Years (Reception and Nursery) and Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2). Children in these year groups will no longer be required to wear blazers, shirts, ties and jumpers—their uniform will comprise of a purple polo shirt and sweat shirt (available from the school office). Children in the Early Years will now only be required to wear black joggers as opposed to formal trousers and skirts. These new uniform items can be worn after the Easter holidays.

## Online Gaming - Fortnite

### So what is it?

Fortnite is an online shooter game that starts with 100 players and leaves one winner standing.

**Battle Royale** sees 100 players parachute onto an island, and the last player alive wins.

Each game lasts about 20 minutes.

It has a PEGI rating of 12 (age 12 and over) for *'frequent scenes of violence'*.

This game is violent – it is a battle to the death, after all - but the violence is rather cartoon-like, it isn't bloody or particularly gory.
