

COVID19 HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

The school will do its best to:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19, isolate them with a familiar adult until you arrive;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 as this will mean you will all need to self-isolate for at least 14 days or until the test comes back negative;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the revised Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlines in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through newsletters and the school website.

As a Parent I will help my child to know and understand that:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for up to 14 days as a family and follow the most up to date stay at home advice provided by the school
- If my child, or another child in the group, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;
- On my commute, and when dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2 metre social distancing rules.
- When dropping off and picking up, I will adhere to the timings and will enter and exit where advised
- My child must not bring any items into school with them or take items home from school except water bottles, a piece of fruit and packed lunch in a disposable carrier bag;
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene - coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- I will not be allowed into the school without a pre- arranged appointment – make appointments via telephone or email;
- Read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home and refer to the school's website for information;
- I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details.
- If my child's behaviour is deemed unsafe, he/she will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

I will do my best to:

- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules in my bubble and in the outside space;
- Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school;
- Only use the equipment provided to me by school;
- Not mix with any other children in the school except my bubble;
- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated entrance;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds/ hand sanitiser regularly;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
