

Temple Grove School Uniform

Nursery – Year 2

Purple Sweatshirt, Purple Polo Shirt and Black jogging trousers or Black Trousers or Black Skirt
Black school shoes (or black trainers for Nursery and Reception children)

Year 3 - Year 6

School Purple Blazer
White Shirt, academy tie, grey jumper with purple trim and academy logo.
Black trousers or skirt
Black, White or grey socks or tights.
Black school shoes – NO TRAINERS

Summer Uniform

Summer Lilac and white dresses
Black shorts

PE Kit

Plain purple T-shirt or purple T-shirt with academy logo, Black shorts, Black plimsolls.
Black sweatshirt and Joggers in Cold weather outside.

Games

Key Stage 2 may need more specialised items e.g. football boots, swimming kit, tracksuits etc.
Parents will be informed when these items will be required.

Hair

Once hair is shoulder length it must be tied back for safety reasons.
Bands and clips should be black, brown or purple.
No large bows for girls.
Boys should have neat, even length haircuts.
No shaved patterns or dyed hair

No nail varnish should be worn to school.
