

Personal, Social & Emotional Development (PSED)

- Revisit class rules and expectations.
- Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others.
- Be confident to speak about their ideas and will independently choose the resources they need
- Begin to negotiate and solve problems without aggression
- Play cooperatively and take turns with others

Physical Development (PD)

- Understanding how to stay healthy
- Move confidently in arrange of ways, negotiating space
- Uses one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. scissors, pencils, hole punch etc.
- Can correctly form numbers, lowercase and capital letters.

Communication & Language (CL)

- Listen to stories and respond with relevant questions and comments
- Follow instructions
- Listen and respond to the ideas of others during a conversation
- Use language to create and imagine roles within a play situation.
- Articulate their ideas and thoughts in well-formed sentences.
- Describe events in some detail.

Understanding the World (UW)

- Understand key features of the life cycle of a plant and an animal
- Recognise some similarities and differences between life in this country and life in other countries
- Recognise some environments that are different to the one they live in
- Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them

Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)

- Investigate different media and materials, creating collages and models
- Introducing narratives and storylines in their play
- Create simple representations of people and objects
- Construct with a purpose in mind
- Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.



Literacy (LIT)

- Writes own name and simple words using clear letters.
- Beginning to write captions, labels and short sentences
- Beginning to read words and simple sentences

- Identify and build numbers up to 20
- Recall number bonds to 10
- Practically add or subtract two single-digit numbers
- Double, half and share quantities
- Compare mass, capacity, length and height
