

Our value focus this term:

Aspiration and Respect

Theme:

Our theme this term is 'Exploration and travel'.

English:

This term we will be looking at the texts 'The Snail and the Whale' and 'Claude in the city'. The Snail and the Whale tells the tale of an adventurous snail travelling the world and Claude in the city is the story of a dog and his side-kick sock who venture into a big city! We will be focusing on writing short narratives and capital letters and full stops.

Phonics:

Phonics will be taught daily to support, reading, writing and spelling. We will be focusing on recapping phase 2 and 3 and introducing phase 4 and 5 sounds as well as reading and blending real and alien words in preparation for the phonics screenings.

Home learning ideas:

Encourage children to practice their phonics (phases 3-5) and look for different sounds in words. This will also be a great tool to help them practice spellings at home using the sounds they have learnt at home and in school.

Science:

We will be looking at Health and Well-being in PSHCE this term and will be supporting children in their transition back to school. In RE we are focusing on Christianity and will look at the creation story and celebrations.

PE:

The children will continue with weekly sessions which will take place on Wednesday and Friday. Children are to come in wearing their kits. We will be starting with gymnastics.

Computing:

We will be following the computing scheme Purple Mash again this year. The children will start with logging on and becoming familiar with a pc. They will then look at online safety and sorting and grouping.
