Nursery

We hope you had a wonderful and restful Easter break. The children have returned to Nursery reenergised and raring to go! This term our topic is Amazing Animals. We started our topic by producing a mind-map of all the animals we know and all the facts we know about them. We then talked about people who help animals when they are unwell and how they help them. The children enjoyed the fun, rhyming tale of *Hairy Maclary's Rumpus at the Vet* by Lynley Dodd and have loved acting out the role of a vet and treating various soft-toy animals in our very own Veterinary Surgery, exploring the equipment vets use and discussing what they might be used for. Mrs Reynolds paid us a visit to discuss her previous role as a veterinary nurse – the children listened beautifully. We are continuing our *Letterland* journey and have been introduced to two new characters - *Jumping Jim* who makes a 'j' sound and *Kicking King* who makes a 'k' sound. I am so impressed with how well the children have retained all the sounds taught to date. Well done Donaldson Class! In maths, we have explored sorting animals and learning all about the number 5. In literacy, we have been practising writing our names – the children are making great progress with their fine motor development and pencil grip. The children had lots of fun at Forest School this week. They all had a go at using a bow saw under the guidance of Mrs Maclean our fantastic Forest School teacher and enjoyed playing with the log swings, swinging on the hammock, concocting dishes in the mud kitchen and climbing trees.
